

Camp Tuhsmeheta Fire Procedure & Policy

A fire drill will be conducted for each new group of visitors within 48 hours of arrival at Camp Tuhsmeheta (Camp T).

- In the event of a fire, an activated fire alarm, odor, or suspicious smoke:
 - 1. Call 911.
 - 2. Radio or call the Camp T site director (517-515-2543) or the Camp T facility manager (810-397-4508).
 - 3. Make sure all group leaders are aware of the fire or possible fire.
 - 4. Gather all group members and report to Center Island. Remain together at Center Island until receiving an "all clear" from Camp T staff.
 - 5. The site director or designee will direct responding authorities to the fire if the location is known.
- If an alarm is set off, Camp T staff will attempt to locate the cause of the alarm.
- If there is a fire, Camp T staff will attempt to confine or extinguish the fire.
- The Camp T site director will complete the Bureau for Child and Adult Licensing (BCAL) Form 4603 (Incident, Accident, Illness, Death, Fire Report) and submit it to the proper authorities
